By working together and following this guidance, we can ensure that every member of our school community feels heard, informed, and valued.

PARENT- SCHOOL COMMUNICATION POLICY

If you have any questions or need to speak to a staff member, please follow the steps below. This ensures your concern is addressed promptly and effectively.

STEP 1: Speak to Class Teacher

If your query is about any of the below, your first port of call is your child's class teacher. Initially, speak with them at the start or end of the day, but more detailed meetings as necessary can be arranged typically within 48 hours.

- + Progress
- + Transition
- + Medical
- + Class work
- + Dietary updates
- + Friendships + Concerns
- + SEND adaptions
- + Missed sessions + Behaviour

STEP 2: Contact a Senior Leader

If you have spoken with your child's teacher and you feel the issue remains, please speak to the appropriate Senior Leader, via contacting the office typically the SLT member will contact you for a follow up discussion or meeting within 48 hours:

- + EYFS: Miss Williams
- + Y1 6: Miss Walker
- + SENDCO: Miss Boon

STEP 3: Speak to the Head of Academy

If you have spoken with a member of SLT and you feel the issue has not been resolved, please speak to Mr Rollin (Head of Academy).

STEP 4: Escalate to the Chair of AAB

You can escalate to the Chair of the AAB if you are unhappy with the outcome of a concern you have made and you feel the Academy has not dealt with it.

PLEASE CONTACT THE SCHOOL SHOULD YOU WISH TO SPEAK TO THE SAFEGUARDING TEAM

- Issues within the family that may affect your child's education, for example: housing, separation, social care
- + Attendance issues
- + Safeguarding concerns or queries
- + Circumstances that affect your child's well-being
